### FRIENDS OF FORT HALIFAX REPORT:

Norma Shearer, member of Friends of Fort Halifax, was present and submitted a report for September 2023. <u>Campfire Historical Speaker Series:</u> Second in a series of our Campfire Historical Speaker Series to be held Saturday, October 28<sup>th</sup>, 2023, from 7:00 p.m. to 8:00 p.m. at Fort Halifax Park. David Biser, portraying John Harris, Jr will be the speaker. Cocoa and s'mores will be offered to the attendees.

**Hornets' Nest:** A hornets' nest was found in the Granary building. The Board of Supervisors advised that Roadmaster Matt Roland will look and decide how to handle the hornets' nest once he returns.

**Skills Trade Project:** Mr. Bob Brightbill applied for and was awarded a \$10,000.00 grant for a Yeager House deck to accommodate an ADA entrance to be built in the Spring/Summer of 2024.

### **ADMINISTRATIVE:**

**PSATS Trustees Insurance & Retirement Services:** The Board of Supervisors requested more information for 2025. The Board of Supervisors didn't feel there is enough information to make an informed decision for 2024 by October 31, 2023.

# **OLD BUSINESS:**

Keiffer Road: No discussion or action taken.

# **NEW BUSINESS:**

Halifax Commons-Time Extension: A Motion was made by Supervisor Schreffler and seconded Supervisor Paul that Halifax Commons must execute a properly submitted Time Extension agreement by November 2<sup>nd</sup>, 2023, for the plan to continue to be reviewed until January 4<sup>th</sup>, 2024. If one is not submitted by November 2<sup>nd</sup>, 2023, the plan will be denied. Vote called. Motion carries 5-0.

**EMS/Ambulance Coverage & UD COG:** The Upper Dauphin Council of Government applied for a Dauphin County Gaming Grant that will not be approved till Spring 2024 to pay for an important professional EMS study to identify solutions to help stabilize and improve EMS/ambulance coverage in the Northern Dauphin County service area. If, Upper Dauphin Council of Government is not awarded the gaming grant, Upper Paxton Township has requested that the Upper Dauphin Council of Government municipalities pledge to reimburse them on the population based fair share of the EMS study cost. Each municipality, who votes to commit, will sign a reimbursement Memorandum of Understanding with Upper Paxton Township. The Board of Supervisors decided to vote at the next Board of Supervisor Meeting scheduled for Monday, November 13<sup>th</sup>, 2023, at 7:00 p.m.

<u>Scheidler Sewage Facilities Planning Module & Resolution:</u> A Motion was made by Supervisor Schreffler and seconded by Supervisor Paul to dispense with the reading of the Scheidler Sewage Facilities Resolution. Vote called. Motion carries 5-0. A Motion was made by Supervisor Schreffler and seconded by Supervisor Paul to approve the Scheidler Sewage Facilities Planning Module and the Resolution. Vote called. **Motion** carriers 5-0.

<u>42 Matamoras Road:</u> After discussion, the Board of Supervisors decided that Chairman Bechtel talk to the property owner and let them know how Halifax Township would like to proceed.

**<u>2023 Volunteer Fire Relief Money:</u>** A **Motion** was made by Supervisor Bruner and seconded by Supervisor Schreffler to donate \$21,372.22 to the Halifax Fire Department. Vote called. **Motion** carries 5-0.

**Board of Supervisors & Planning Commission Meeting Dates:** A **Motion** was made by Supervisor Schreffler and seconded by Supervisor Paul to accept and approve the advertisement of the Board of Supervisors and Planning Commission Monthly Meeting Days for 2024. Vote called. **Motion** carries 5-0.

**Fort Halifax Feasibility Study:** Supervisor McBurney gave a brief update on the Fort Halifax Feasibility Study. Discussion will continue at the next Board of Supervisors meeting, scheduled for Monday, November 13<sup>th</sup>, 2023.

Diners & Fast Food: The Board of Supervisors don't feel that it is Halifax Township's concern.
