Continue working on SALDO....Changes/Corrections/Clarifications/Additions – Discussion continued on changes/corrections/clarifications/additions for the SALDO. **Motion** was made by Randy Paul and second by Fred Ford to change the size of sheds from 600 square feet to 300 square feet and keep the setback at 5 feet. Vote called. Motion carries 5-0.

There was discussion about mailboxes and clearances from the curb. There is a discrepancy with PennDOT's definition of a setback and the United States Postal Service setbacks. Also, a definition of a monument structure will be worked on for the SALDO.
